**Ans** :- Workplace violence is any act or threat of physical violence, harassment, intimidation, or other threatening disruptive behavior that occurs at the workplace. Workplace violence includes threats and verbal abuse to physical assaults and even homicide. It can affect and involve employees, clients, customers and visitors.

## Que :- What are the examples of workplace violence?

Ans:- following are the few examples of workplace violence:

- Threatening Behavior such as shaking fists, destroying property, throwing objects etc.
- Verbal or written threats any expression of an intent to inflict harm
- Verbal abuse swearing, insults or condescending language
- Physical attacks hitting, shoving, pushing or kicking
- Harassment, including sexual harassment
- Stalking
- Making obscene or threatening phone calls or sending threatening emails or text messages
- Posting obscene or threatening messages on social media sites
- Spreading rumors or making false statements about another person
- Tampering with another person's personal belongings
- Destroying another person's property
- Cyberbullying
